OBJECTIVES FOR PRIVATE VOICE LESSONS

Private voice lessons are designed to

- 1) continue singers' auditory and written music understanding
- 2) build confidence and flexibility in the singers individual sound and style
- 3) build a working repertoire of songs that introduce the singer to a variety of musical styles and provide a "repertoire book" of audition and performance pieces.

In a 30 minute lesson the singer will; warm up, do a brief music theory / sight singing and work on assigned repertoire.

REFUND/CANCELLATION POLICY

Cancellations must be completed 1 week prior to the first day of lessons. Full refunds will be given to those who cancel within that 1-week period via their original form of payment. If cancelling within the week of lessons, a 15% deduction will be processed for each late cancellation day (Ex. Lessons starts on Saturday, but you cancel the Sunday before a 15% deduction will be applied, if cancelling on Monday a 30% deduction will be processed from your refund etc.). Please allow 5-7 business days for the refund to be issued. We reserve the right to cancel any lessons at any time, and if we do so will issue a FULL Refund via the original form of payment.

RULES & EXPECTATIONS

Attendance:

- Students should arrive 5 minutes before their scheduled lesson and wait outside the office door.
- Bring the following...
 - Yellow reperatiore binder, pencil, practice journal and water.
- Fort Wayne Youtheatre cannot be held responsible for students leaving the building with or without parental permission.

Excused or Unexcused... That is the question!

- Excused Absence Notification to instructor one week in advance in lesson or via email. We can plan a make up for an upcoming Saturday (Example upcoming tech week for a show)
- Unexcused Absence No notification or arriving 10 minutes late.
 - No make-up will be offered.
- Please note an extra week has been built into the schedule to cover if we have poor driving conditions or the teacher is too ill to teach at some point during the semester. Notifications will come via text.
- Make-ups are offered for illness. Fevers and colds and flus need rest! We can sing through bad allergy days and "icky" cold symptoms after the main symptoms have subsided.
- No more than 5 make-up lessons within a singular semester.
